

Primary School Programme Class I to IV

The focus on developing communication skills helps them appreciate the value of education, as it reflects in their ability to express themselves, in addition to developing practical skills.

Education trips, excursions, activities and presentations provide experiential learning opportunities. Dance, Fine Arts, Yoga, Music and speech promote well-rounded development. Students are encouraged to participate in inter-house cultural and sports events. Book, newspaper, magazine reading activities increase children's awareness of the world.

Middle School Programme Class V to VIII
